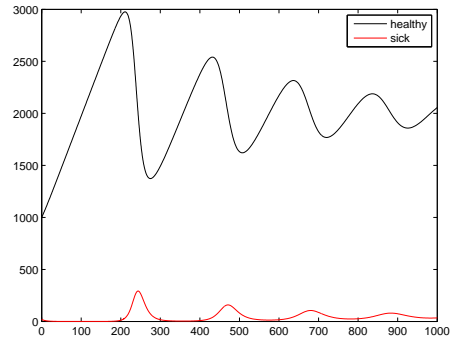


Plots for the recurring epidemic
